Teen Court is a unique program designed to reduce the rates of recidivism in teens, ages 11-17, using a peer to peer education model. Teen Court Volunteers (TCV) help to provide positive influence and sanctions to other students who have committed first-time misdemeanor offenses in our local community. Volunteers also gain valuable real-life skills and experience by serving as courtroom jurors, clerks, bailiffs and attorneys during court cases.

## WHO

Volunteer youth must be 6th through 12th grade students that reside in Wilson County, NC.

## LOCATION

Teen Court hearings are held at the Wilson County courthouse. The Teen Court office is conveniently located next door to the courthouse.
